**Secondly, one of the most needed programs in social services is a pantry program that distributes bags and hot meals to individuals and families. Yet, individuals are striving to volunteer, but many desire to volunteer for the wrong purpose. An individual may have expertise in professional classifications such as computer hardware, data processing, human resources or financial management; but, the volunteer positions may be to load large boxes of food that include dry goods or vegetables, mopping floors, unloading trucks, preparing meals/making food bags, cleaning tables or even making pick-ups. This doesn't take away from your professional abilities; this is where the help is needed.**

**Finally, eventually with your help, opportunities may prevail where professional skills yield a need, and the volunteer opportunity becomes open for the growth and the need of that non-profit."**
