Start seeking self defense classes within your neighborhood. Better to be prepared than unprepared.

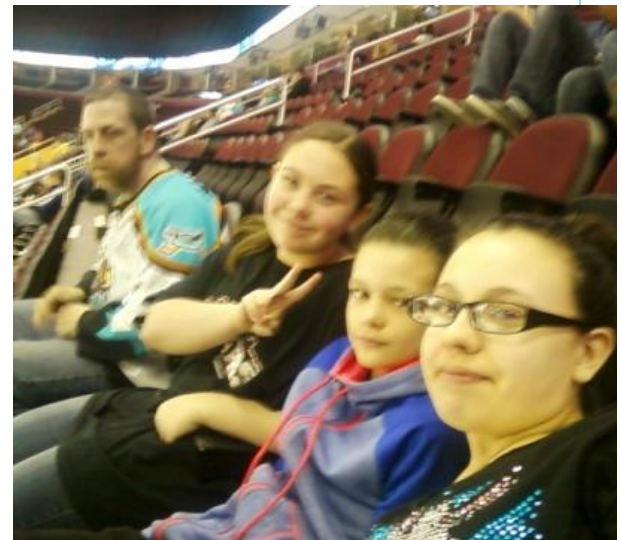
